NOTICE – ORGANIZED HAMLET OF GUERNSEY

Recently there have been more issues and complaints regarding pets at large within the Hamlet. This notice serves to advise that all pets are in the Hamlet solely at the owner's risk. The Hamlet has a bylaw pertaining to dogs at large (this bylaw is enforceable and fines are issued by Flaman Investigation & Security); however, there is no bylaw for cats as this is nearly impossible to enforce. This does **NOT** mean that cats can be at large within the Hamlet.

For their safety, ALL ANIMALS belonging to you must be contained in YOUR yard or home. Animals walked outside of your property must be contained or leashed at all times. If your animal or your neighbour's animal is at large and causes an issue or is injured, this is solely the responsibility of the owners. Please be respectful of other residents, their pets, and property.

Council & the Hamlet Board ask that all residents comply to this policy and do their best to work together. Questions or concerns may be brought forward to any member of Council or the Hamlet Board.
