## An Important Message from the Drake & District Fire Department

With harvest season in full swing, field and grassland fires are at the focus of many farmers in our area. When a fire starts in a field or yard, farmers often act as first responders, using personal equipment to contain and suppress the fire. While these heroic efforts are often a critical component in managing rural fires, the Drake & District Fire Department would like to remind individuals of some crucial points of firefighting safety and liability.

- 1) Any individual responding to a fire scene who is not a registered member of the Drake & District Fire Department, is participating of their own free will. By doing so, you are assuming all risk and liability. The Fire Department and associated municipalities are not responsible for injuries, accidents, damages to personal property or death that may result.
- 2) All individuals attending a fire scene **MUST FIRST** report to the Fire Chief or delegate on scene.
- 3) Always prioritize your own safety, stay alert and follow any directives given to you by the Fire Chief or attending delegate.
